SUNNYSIDE CEMETERY WILLOW RIVER, MINNESOTA 55795 RULES (ADOPTED MARCH 7, 2005)

- 1. Burial vaults are mandatory for full burials.
- 2. The sexton (City Clerk), must be notified when burying cremation remains.
- 3. Flat stones must be set in a minimum of a 4" cement collar.
- 4. Setting and care of all stones remains the responsibility of the family or families.
- 5. Headstones must be set on a cement base with a minimum 4" larger than stone base.
- 6. Artificial flowers may be placed on graves from Mother's Day through Father's Day. They must put in containers, off the ground the remainder of the year.
- 7. All urn planters must be set on the side of the headstone or flat stone, and must be at least 2 ft. off the ground. And cannot be set in cement.
- 8. No trees or shrubs may be planted near the grave site.
- 9. Anything placed in the cemetery, other than headstones or flat stones, may not be placed in cement and needs approval from the Willow River City Council.
- 10. Garbage cans for cemetery use only.
- 11. The Willow River City Council reserves the right to remove any and all plantings and displays, not in compliance with the ordinance.
- 12. Vehicles are permitted on the designated driving lanes only.
- 13. The City of Willow River allows one (1) headstone per lot and (1) flat stone per burial, (Cremations, etc)..
